Photography

Anyone using photography or video equipment must register their name and address with the tournament organizers.

Neither Avalon Archers, The Howard Bowmen or the owners of the land can accept liability for damage or injury howsoever caused to any person or property whilst on, entering or leaving the grounds.

GDPR: By entering our shoot, the information provided on each entry form will be collected and stored by the Clubs Tournament Organiser. This data may include Name, Gender, Bow Style, Age Category, Round to be shot, Archery-Related Disability information, Postal Address, Email address, Telephone number, Archery Club, Archery GB Membership Number. This data will not be used by, sold or transferred to anyone other than the Tournament Office Organiser. This data will not be used for anything other than management of this tournament and all related correspondence, Target & Result lists may be published on the Field Archery website and facebook sites. An individual may request to see personal data held about them and/or request to be "forgotten" by making a request to the tournament organiser. Contact details will be held for one year, results will be held indefinitely for historical purposes.

BASIC TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES AND TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entry criteria and issues relating to an archer's age and the round they shoot

The table below, see last page of entry form, provides a guide on the pegs that an archer should shoot, this is based on age or experience in competing at Field Archery

Archers may enter into any of the bow styles and any of the peg colours that they wish, however awards will only be given for archers competing in the categories outlined in the table

Entry fee, withdrawals, refunds, replacements

- No refund will be given to an archer who withdraws his/her entry after the closing date
- An archer withdrawing from the shoot before the closing date has the right to submit the name of an alternate archer to take his/her place. The alternate archer's name must be submitted in the same email/letter as the cancellation - otherwise the position will be immediately offered to another archer (if there is a waiting list).
- If an archer withdraws and submits the name of an alternate archer with their AGB number, it is the responsibility of those two archers to resolve the entry fee issue between themselves.
- All withdrawals / cancellations must be received by the closing date. Cancellations need to be sent to the tournament organiser using the email address on the entry form.
- Archers who do not turn up on the day of the shoot and who have not submitted their written withdrawal will not be entitled to a refund
- Acceptance into the competition is at the discretion of The Howard Bowmen and the club reserves the right to refuse entry.

Smoking/Vaping and Alcohol

Smoking, Vaping, and the Possession of/Consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited within the venue or its grounds. This covers all archers and non-archers present for the entire duration of the shoot. The one exception is at the refreshment area where smoking / vaping is permitted

Dogs & Pets

Dogs & Pets are not permitted on the grounds

Photography

To Photographers: Photography is permitted only if the archer, or person taking the photographs, submits their name and contact details before the shoot, and/or completes the "photography register" on the day of the shoot.

To Archers: Please be aware that photographs may be taken during the day (photographers will be registered) – if you have any issues with this, please speak to the tournament organiser on the day OR directly to the photographer to ensure that any issues can be avoided and/or resolved.

Archers are not permitted to use cameras or phones throughout the tournament as both days consist of unmarked distance targets

Bowstyles

Cross bows are not permitted at any of our venues.

Behaviour/Conduct

All people attending the tournament (archers, spectators etc) will be expected to behave correctly throughout the duration of the shoot. We as a club, encourage a friendly atmosphere and do our best to ensure everybody (archers and spectators) enjoys their day. Laughter, encouragement and even some friendly rivalry is to be expected but we will not accept bullying, mocking, intimidation or abusive language aimed at anyone.

Results/Scores

To ensure that the results process goes as smoothly as possible, please ensure that your score cards are clearly legible, that the totals are written correctly (and double-checked) before signing – and that both the archer and the scorer have signed the score sheets and both score sheets are submitted to the organiser as soon as possible on the completion of shooting each day. If these are not done, it will only cause added delays. Scores will be collated at the end of the shoot and the Provisional Results will be read out – please note that due to time restrictions the accuracy of the provisional results may not be 100%. We do our best to try to ensure that they are as accurate as possible, but this is not always possible. During the week after the event, all scores will be double-checked and the FINAL results will then be issued (usually around a week-or-so after the shoot).

We do not give back your score cards so if you wish to keep a copy for your own records, then you can request a copy to be emailed to you after the results have been issued.
